Dear CHCS Family,

After months of searching across the nation for our next Administrator, the Chapel Hill Christian School Board of Education is pleased to announce that God has led us to one of our own. On Friday, April 29, 2011, Reverend John Wilson accepted the call to serve as Administrator of CHCS. This announced decision comes after a unanimous recommendation by our eight-member Search Committee and a unanimous vote of approval by the Board of Education. Reverend Wilson plans to begin his new role on May 31, 2011. We are thankful to God for guiding us to the person He has called to lead CHCS, continuing to uphold our school's longstanding, Christ-honoring presence in the community. Reverend Wilson possesses the qualities, character, experiences and abilities to successfully lead our school into the future. We are very proud to present him to you as our new Administrator.

Reverend Wilson received his Bachelor's degree in Psychology from Taylor University, and also attended Asbury Seminary where he received his Master's of Divinity degree. He is an ordained pastor with the Christian and Missionary Alliance. He has served as Senior Pastor of Tallmadge Alliance Church for the past nine years. During that period Reverend Wilson and his wife, Laura, have actively related to Chapel Hill Christian School in many capacities. Mrs. Wilson has served as a Teacher's Aid and as the Pre-Kindergarten Teacher at both our Green and North campuses. Reverend Wilson has been a volunteer for the school as a chapel speaker, coach and speech meet instructor. He especially enjoys read-aloud times in our classes and has been abundantly blessed by visits to Guatemala with our Connecting Hearts Ministry.

Prior to his pastoral ministry, Reverend Wilson served at Wesley Biblical Seminary and the Barnabas Foundation. At Wesley he held the position of Vice President of Student Development and Institutional Advancement. In this role, he was responsible for admissions, recruitment, financial aid, student life, discipleship, and representing the seminary for preaching and advancement. He also ministered God's Word through conferences, camp meetings, colleges and churches on behalf of the seminary and provided discipleship ministry to future pastors, missionaries and Christian educators.

Prior to these positions, Reverend Wilson worked in the business world for nine years in the Wilson family-owned and operated D&M Express, a mid-sized trucking company that provided interstate hauling for steel mills, foundries and the automobile industry. Reverend Wilson completed his time in the family business as Vice President of Sales and Operations following the untimely death of his father.

Reverend and Mrs. Wilson have three children. Krista, their oldest, is married to Mr. Christopher Thomas, who is studying engineering at the University of Illinois, Chicago. Krista is majoring in Music and Bible, and Theology at Moody Bible Institute. They are both graduates of CVCA. The Wilson's younger children, John and Emma, are currently students at CVCA and both graduated from Chapel Hill Christian School. Reverend Wilson also graduated from CHCS and his mother served as a Pre-kindergarten teacher here, as well. He completed sixth grade in 1969, and is thrilled to return to CHCS 42 years later in the formal capacity of Administrator. Chapel Hill Christian School has been such a tremendous blessing to the Wilson Family, and they are excited about continuing to serve with us for all the Lord wants to accomplish in our future!
