

SCHOOL UNIFORM DRESS CODE – NORTH CAMPUS ONLY

There is a three-fold purpose for our dress code: 1) To give our students a distinctive look, 2) To diminish clothing competition and distractions, and 3) To provide affordable and quality clothing options. Students are required to wear approved uniforms daily. Uniforms are to have school emblems (available in the school store) on them. The emblems should be placed on the upper left side (over the heart) of girls’ jumpers and boys’ shirts. Red shirts are to be a true red and not cranberry. Items marked in **bold** MUST BE PURCHASED from SchoolBelles Kids Kloset or Lowry’s. Items with an ** MUST BE PURCHASED from SchoolBelles, Kids Kloset, Lowry’s, JC Penney Uniform Shop, Target Uniforms, or Land’s End. Chapel Uniform is required on Mondays for North students and Fridays for Green students. Chapel uniform is required for weekly Chapel services at both the North and Green campus.

*** New – boys shirts (oxfords, knit polo, turtlenecks, sweaters must have CHCS emblem.**

DRESS CODE for “OUT OF UNIFORM” DAYS

Pants	Students may wear jeans or slacks. No biking (Spandex) pants, sweat pants or tights. Pants may not have holes or questionable patches. Girls may wear loose fitting Capri's. Students may wear walking shorts or any shorts within code stipulation of no more than 2" above knee. (First day to 10/31 & 4/1 to last day)
Shorts	
Tops	No tank tops No “Rock Groups” or improper sayings on shirts. (Example: No Bart Simpson, or large novelty logos such as store names.
Skirt/Dress	Girls may wear “Code Length” skirts or dresses if they prefer.
Shoes	No sandals, clogs, cleats, cowboy boots, or high fashion boots.

All *Out of Uniform* days must be approved by the Administrator.

Enforcement of the Dress Code

Students coming to school out of uniform should bring a note of explanation to the teacher. If an out of code situation continues, the office will contact the home for further explanation. If the situation is not rectified, it will be treated as a disciplinary issue. Please call the office with any questions.

Notes:

Girl's blouses and knit shirts *are not* to have an emblem. An emblem is required on the jumper. Girl's polo and turtlenecks shirts can be worn with either the jumper, skirts (5th-6th grade), walking shorts, capris or skorts (5th -6th grade). Shirts must be loose fitting. Physical Education classes require gym shorts under jumpers or skirts and gym shoes.
