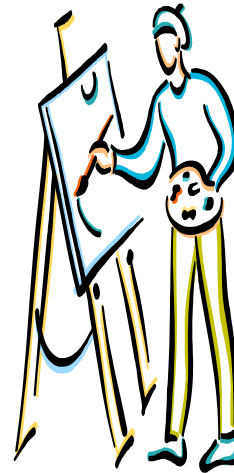

If you need a form, they are available in the information racks located in the school foyer, or you may download them from the CHCS website. Join us today and begin a fitter, healthier New Year!

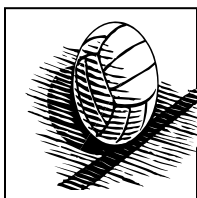


School Supplies for Guatemala
