This Thursday is Icee Treat Day for all students who beat the score of a staff member or teacher they challenged.

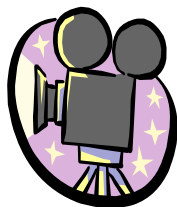
Tuesday, Feb. 17th is Bowl-A-Thon Out of Uniform Day for those students that landed on this special space of the Prize Wheel.
