The people in Jerusalem were quite a fickle bunch. On Sunday, they praised Jesus, shouting, "Hosanna, blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!" By Friday, the same crowd shouted, "Crucify Him! Crucify Him!" What happened? Why the change of heart? The Jewish people were looking for a Messiah, someone to free them from Roman rule. They were sure Jesus was their man. So, when he came into Jerusalem on that fateful Sunday, they expected him to ride straight to the Roman governor and let him know it was time to step down, Jesus was in the house! But, Jesus did not do that. Instead, he went into the temple, rid it of the money changers and left town. The crowd was disappointed and mad. Jesus did not do what they wanted or expected him to do.

What do we do when Jesus does not do what we expect of him? Our loved one is not healed. We do not get the job. Our bills are still unpaid. Our prayers were not answered. Many times we are like the Jerusalem crowd. We become angry with God. We turn against Him. We lose our faith and trust.

You see, God looks beyond the moment and into the eternal. He loves us so much He gives us what we NEED, not what we WANT. The true test of our faith and trust is to shout "Hosanna, blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!" even when He is not doing what we expect.

As we celebrate this Easter season and the resurrection of our Lord, let us remember that because of His sacrifice at Calvary, we have forgiveness of sins. Because of the empty tomb, we have eternal life. His plans are much better than ours!
