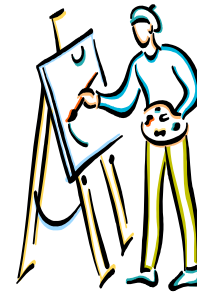


CHCS 2009 Candy Sale. . .
