At a recent Administrator's Conference, I attended a workshop on character development. Character development is the most important job we as Christian parents and teachers face. During the workshop, the instructor brought to our attention that the most important virtue we can develop in our children is gratitude. Cicero stated hundreds of year ago, "Gratitude is not only the greatest of virtues, but the parent of all others." Michale Zigareli, author of Cultivating Christian Character, states that "growing our student's gratitude has a radical and transformational effect on character because gratitude is one of Gods primary vehicles for inducing other Christian qualities." It is not easy to cultivate a heart of gratitude in our materialistic, consumer-driven society. However, if our children are going to be effective for Christ, they must first learn to be grateful for His many blessings.

Here are some suggestions for developing this quality in our children:

- Resist a consumptive lifestyle
- Live counter-culturally by identifying the lie that wealth is the measure of a person
- Persevere - quitting is not an option
- Become self-disciplined - embrace and celebrate delayed gratification
- Overcome the temptation of self-indulgence
- Cultivate a heart of gratitude.
