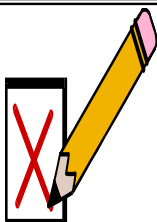
*From The Principal's*

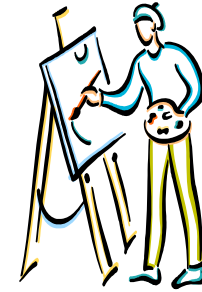

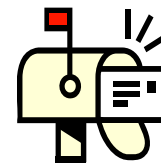
