School will be dismissed at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, June 5. There will be no daycare available. You will need to make arrangements to have your child picked up by 1:00.

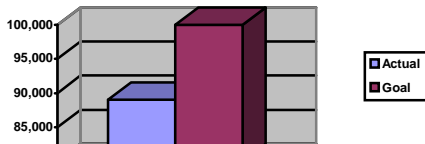
The following school districts will run buses for our students at 1:00:

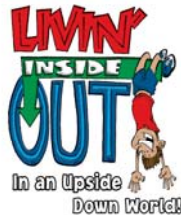
