An Attitude of Gratitude

I am reading John Ortberg's latest book, When the Game Is Over, It All Goes Back in the Box. In it, Mr. Ortberg discusses what is most important in life and stresses that a crucial component of all of our lives should be gratitude.

An attitude of gratitude does not come naturally. It is something that must be taught and cultivated. Mr. Ortberg gives some excellent ways for all of us to improve our gratitude attitudes:

1. At the end of each day, list in a journal 5 things that happened that day for which you are grateful. Talk about these with your children and help them notice even small things like the beautiful green grass or warm sunshine.
2. Make your children work for things they want. Help them learn to save their money for something rather than buying it for them or having them pay you back. Let them learn what it means to save their money. Mr. Ortberg warns that children develop a spirit of entitlement rather than thankfulness when they have so many 'things.' We cannot be grateful when we've never wanted for anything.
3. Give to others. Work in a food pantry or mission. Visit shelters and volunteer to help those less fortunate.
4. Teach your children to write thank you notes when someone has given them a gift or done something nice for them.
5. Model a thankful heart in your actions and speech.

I want to let you all know that I am grateful for the opportunity to watch your children grow and develop Christian character. I am thankful for their smiles and hugs and the funny things they say. I am grateful for the privilege I have to partner with you in their education. Thank you for bringing them to CHCS!

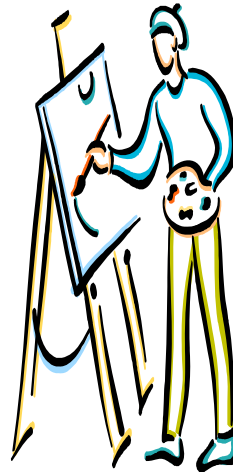
