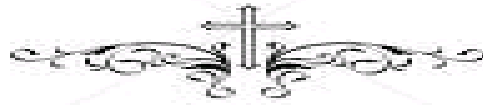
*From the Principal's*



*In Philippians 4:12, Paul tells us, "I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation." Learning to be thankful in all circumstances is not the same as giving God thanks for cancer or some other terrible event. God uses tragedies, but His purposes are always for healing and wholeness, not for disease or destruction. So being content and thankful in all circumstances means seeing God's hand and provision even, or especially, in the midst of hard, or even terrible, situations. The "secret" of contentment therefore is to focus on our faithful, merciful God and the way He redeems the worst situations in our lives.*

*Paul wrote this letter to the Philippians to thank them for all their support while he was in prison. Even though he was grateful, Paul also wanted to assure the Philippians that the many trials that he had endured for the gospel had taught him to be content regardless of his circumstances. Paul's statement affirms that there is no situation for which God will not supply what is needed. This is true not only for Paul, but also for the Philippians – and us – as well.*

*We live in difficult times. Many families are facing financial, physical, and relational hardships. It is easy to lose our perspective and hope when life overwhelms us. However, we do serve a mighty God who loves us and wants our best. As we gather around our Thanksgiving tables next week, we can be content in the fact that He is walking with us and will sustain us through even our most difficult days.*

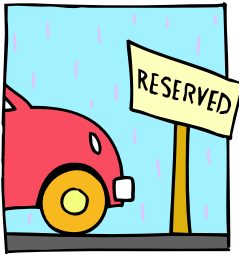

## Did You Know ?

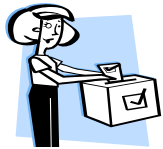
