The first 17 verses of the first chapter of the Gospel of Matthew are not generally considered a part of the Christmas story. In fact, I would wager that most of us skip right over these verses and get to the meat of the story in verse 18. These verses list the genealogy of Jesus, tracing his family tree all the way to Abraham. In these verses you will find the names of some pretty notorious people: murderers, liars, thieves, adulterers, and many, many idolaters. There are some people listed who did great things for God and are examples for all of us to live by. There are others who were a disgrace to God's kingdom. Even a few women are listed – something unheard of in the ancient Jewish culture when listing your family tree – a prostitute and an adulterer.

What does all this have to do with Christmas? Everything. When God sent His son, it was not solely for the rich, or the perfect, or the powerful. Jesus came for everyone – the terrible sinners, the wise, the foolish, the lowest in society and the highest, men and women alike. We are all included in the redemption story. These verses are God's way of saying, "I love all of you. You are all welcome in my family."

So, when you sit down to read the Christmas story this year, start at Matthew 1:1. Help your children understand the extent of God's love to all mankind. The angel said it perfectly, "I bring you good news of great joy that will be for *all* the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you: He is Christ the Lord!"
