

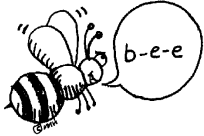
What's New on *The Horizon* at Green

One of the messages God has allowed me to express is found in what I call "A Formula for Success": B+E+E=S, taken from my life's motto: "In Christ you can BEE your best!"

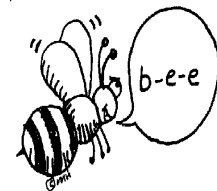
B means: Be aware of who you are. You are a wonderful creation of God and there is nobody else like you.
