Well, Imagine That!

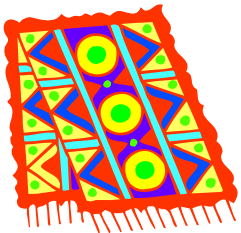
Money keeps *trickling* in for our well project. Our total is now \$465.35. Let's think *spring* – and increase the money flow so running water can be a reality for our African friends!

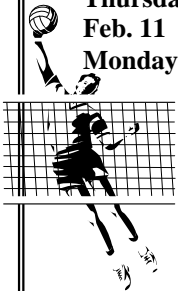
