Cold Weather Wear

Please ensure that your children have the appropriate clothing for outdoor recess. Ohio weather can change drastically from morning to noon, so please always come prepared for cold weather!

Please restrict your use of "excused notes" for winter recess to only significant health-related concerns.

Teachers will consider not having an outdoor recess when the temperature drops below 25 degrees Fahrenheit. The teacher will consider other factors such as age of the class or wind-chill factor. Younger students will be less likely to go outside on cold days. It is our desire to protect your child from severe weather or worsening a present illness.
