If you re-enroll on this date you will be locked into the \$75 re-enrollment (activity) fee!

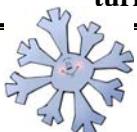
Re-Enrollment packets were sent home earlier this week. Make sure you have them ready to turn in next Friday, February 15th!

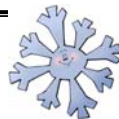

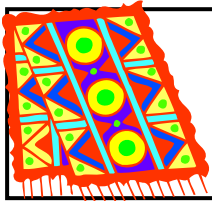
The Blizzard of Books is Here!



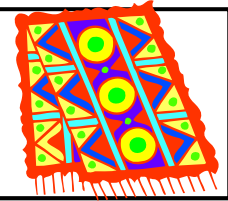
